Saturday, May 6, 10:00 am

Join the Glacier State Paddlers for a fun day canoeing on the Milwaukee River in the Kewaskum area. This will be an easy, pleasant 8 to 9-mile paddle. The trip will start at Parkview Drive in Kewaskum and will end at Commerce St in the village of Barton just north of West Bend. You can get to the start by taking Hwy 45 north into Kewaskum and turning right on Hwy 28. Parkview Drive will be a short distance from there.

We leave at 10:00 am to shuttle vehicles from the start before beginning the trip, so please arrive **Paddling Trip** before then. The trip should take 2 to 3 hours, so a bag lunch is optional. Please bring a beverage **June 11** and gloves to protect your hands.

Grafton to Thiensville Milwaukee River GSP Paddling Trip

Sunday, May 14, 10:00 am

Join the Glacier State Paddlers for a fun day canoeing or kayaking on the Milwaukee River from Treasurer Grafton to Thiensville. The first half of this 10-mile trip will have some twisty turns, and the second half will be easy. The trip will start at Lime Kiln Park just south of Grafton and will end at Village Park in Thiensville.

You can get to the start by taking the Hwy 60 Grafton exit off I-43. Turn left and go west 1.5 miles, then turn left on Hwy 57 (Wisconsin Ave). After 1.75 miles, turn left on W Falls Rd and after 0.25 miles turn right on Green Bay Rd and the park which will be a short distance from there. We leave at 10:00 am to shuttle vehicles from the start before beginning the trip, so please arrive before then. The trip should take a little over 3 hours.

Please bring a bag lunch and beverage for the trip and gloves to protect your hands. Join the Glacier State Paddlers for a fun day canoeing or kayaking on the Milwaukee River from @nordicskiclub.org Thiensville to Kletzsch Park in Glendale. The trip will start on the Milwaukee River by Thiensville Village Park in Thiensville. You can get there by taking I-43 north to Mequon Rd and going west about 3 miles. Turn north (right) on Cedarburg Rd which becomes Main St and after 1/3 mile turn right onto Green Bay Rd. Take the first right at Elm St that will lead to the park.

We leave at 10:00 am to shuttle vehicles from the start before beginning the trip, so please arrive before then. The trip distance is about 9 miles. Please bring a bag lunch and beverage for the trip and gloves to protect your hands.

• Round-trip Amtrak train ticket from Milwaukee Intermodal Station to Union Station in downtown Chicago.

- Round-trip Water Taxi ticket on the Chicago River to Ping Tom Memorial Park.
- Dim sum lunch in Chinatown. Cost also includes taxes and tips.

<u>Trip Itinerary:</u> Participants need to arrive at the Intermodal Station by 7:30 am, located on 433 W St Paul Ave, Milwaukee, WI 53203. (Parking is available at the station for \$8 per day.) We will board an Amtrak train, with group seating. The train leaves at 8:05 am and arrives at Union Station around 9:30 am. We will walk to the Water Taxi at 2 N Riverside Plaza (8-minute walk). Our 10:00 am water taxi (with rest rooms) will sail south on the Chicago River to their dock at Ping Tom Park (30-minute ride). In the event the train arrives late, the taxi runs every 30 minutes and our tickets are good all day. From the park we walk 3-4 blocks to Chinatown.

We will have a family style lunch around noon. Dim Sum is a southern China cuisine that serves a variety of dishes in small plates. We will have dozens of dishes to taste. You can choose what you like to eat. After the lunch, we tour Chinatown, visit landmark buildings, shop souvenir stores, Chinese food markets, tea shops, a bakery, and more.

We will return to Union Station via the Water Taxi departing from Ping Tom Park around 4:00 pm. The train leaves at 5:08 pm to return to Milwaukee. The trip will occur rain or shine. Please note walking is required including stairs from the river to the street level.

Limited to 12 participants and NSCM members only. Participants can invite one guest per member. Once the trip limit has been reached, you can contact Joy if you wish to be put on the waiting list.
